Our use of cookies

Coremetrix uses cookies on our websites and on the websites of our clients and business partners, which include website owners and financial services (“Clients”). You can find out more about cookies and how to control them in the information below.

By using our websites on Coremetrix.com, mygini.com and / or the websites of our clients, you accept the use of cookies in accordance with this Cookie Notice. You accept the use of Analytics and Functionality Cookies for the purposes described below.

If you do not accept the use of these cookies, please disable them using the instructions in this cookie notice, for instance by following the ‘opt-out’ links provided below or by changing your browser settings so that cookies from these websites cannot be placed on your computer or mobile device.

What is a cookie?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit, or to another website that recognises that cookie. Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognise a user’s device.

Cookies do lots of different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, and generally improving the user experience. They can also help to ensure that adverts you see online are more relevant to you and your interests.

N.B. Rest assured that the cookies we use do not contain personal details like your name, telephone numbers, e-mail, or postal addresses.

There are two broad categories of cookies:

- First party cookies, served directly by Coremetrix to your computer;
- Third party cookies, which are served by a third party on Coremetrix’s behalf. We use third party cookies for web analytics.

How does Coremetrix use cookies?

We use cookies on our websites and our clients’ websites to:

- customise and enhance your online experience.
- enable us to advertise both on and off our website.
- monitor our site performance and to improve our websites; and
- understand the total number of visitors on our sites, the types of internet browsers and the operating systems used by our website users.

Analytics cookies

Coremetrix uses (Google) analytics cookies to collect information about how visitors use our website. This information is used to help us improve our website. The information is collected in a way that does not directly identify anyone.
